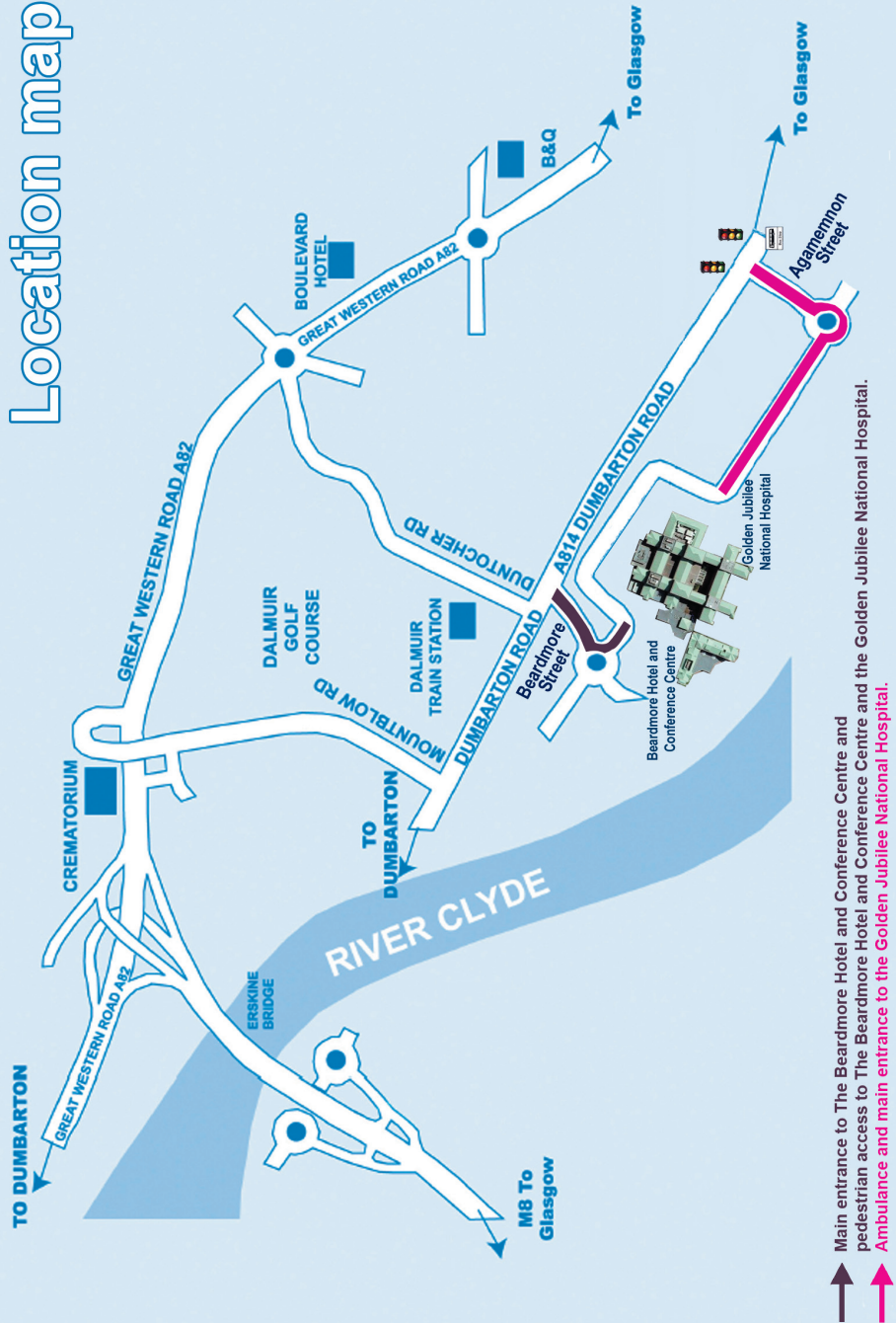


# Location map

## Getting here

The Golden Jubilee National Hospital is centrally located in Clydebank, within easy reach of Glasgow city centre and Glasgow International Airport.

Dalmuir train station is just a 20 minute walk away and numerous buses stop along Dumbarton Road, a five-minute walk from the hospital.

Our in-house Transport team provide a service to the hospital seven days a week, transferring patients from wards and clinics to either their home or a pre-arranged drop-off point (normally another hospital). If you think you may have difficulty travelling to the Golden Jubilee National Hospital, please discuss this with our Booking Office.

For car users, the hospital has 482 free car parking spaces, including 15 disabled bays. Additional spaces are also available at the Beardmore Hotel and Conference Centre.

## Public transport



### Bus routes

The nearest bus stop is on Dumbarton Road, which is also just a few minutes walk from the hospital. Regular services run towards Glasgow, Dumbarton, Balloch and Helensburgh. From Glasgow city centre you can take the First Glasgow bus nos: 66, 204, 205, 215, 216. Please note that the number 62 takes you only as far as Clydebank bus terminal.



## By rail, Dalmuir Station

Take a low level train from either Glasgow Queen Street or Central Station to Dalmuir Station. The Golden Jubilee National Hospital is situated approximately 20 minutes walk from the station (see location map). There are frequent trains running into the city centre and to Loch Lomond; both destinations are an approximate 20 minute journey.



## Glasgow International Airport

Situated at Junction 28a, M8 to the west of Glasgow, the Golden Jubilee National Hospital is an approximate 15 minute drive from the airport. Use M8/M898 (see location map), then follow route map.



## By car

### From North and North East

- Coming down from Dundee / Perth / Stirling on the M80.
- Continue onto the A80 (signs for Glasgow / Carlisle / M73).
- At the roundabout, take the third exit onto the M80 heading to Greenock/M8.
- Merge onto the M8.
- At junction 17, exit toward Dumbarton / A82.
- Turn right at A82 / Great Western Road.
- Travel for approximately 15 minutes.
- At the roundabout, take the first exit onto the B8055 / Drumry Road.
- Turn left at A8014 / Kilbowie Road.
- At the bottom of Kilbowie Road, turn right onto Dumbarton Road and proceed for approximately one quarter of a mile before turning left into Agamemnon Street.
- At the mini roundabout, turn right into the hospital and hotel complex.

### From East

- Coming from Edinburgh follow the M8 to Glasgow.
- Leave the M8 at Junction 19, Clydebank / SECC A814.
- Follow the A814 / Dumbarton Road to Clydebank for approximately 15-20 minutes.
- Turn left into Agamemnon Street.
- At the mini roundabout, turn right into the hospital and hotel complex.

### From South

- From the A74 take the M74 then the M73 followed by the M8 to Glasgow City Centre (avoid Glasgow S.E.).
- Leave the M8 at Junction 19, Clydebank / SECC A814.
- Follow the A814 / Dumbarton Road to Clydebank for approximately 15-20 minutes.
- Turn left into Agamemnon Street.
- At the mini roundabout, turn right into the hospital and hotel complex.

### From Ayrshire

- Coming from Ayr / Stranraer / Kilmarnock on the A77.
- Take the M77, then leave the M77 at Junction 1 and head towards the Clyde Tunnel A739.
- Travel through the Clyde Tunnel, take the second exit A814 to Clydebank for approximately four miles.
- Turn left into Agamemnon Street.
- At the mini roundabout, turn right into the hospital and hotel complex.

### From Renfrewshire / Inverclyde

- At Junction 30 on M8 go to the M896 over the Erskine Bridge.
- Follow the signs for Glasgow (right hand lane), do not join the A82 but remain in the left hand lane which runs alongside the A82, heading for Clydebank A814. Remain on the slip road that crosses over the A82, continue for approximately half a mile.
- At the bottom of Mountblow Road turn left at the traffic lights onto Dumbarton Road.
- Continue until you come to a set of traffic lights. Go through the first and second set of lights and continue along Dumbarton Road for approximately one quarter of a mile.
- Turn right into Agamemnon Street.
- At the mini roundabout, turn right into the hospital and hotel complex.

### From North-West

- Follow the A82 through Dumbarton.
- At Dunglass Roundabout take the second exit - A814 Bowling and Old Kilpatrick.
- At the second roundabout through Bowling and Old Kilpatrick, take the second exit to Clydebank (dual carriageway).
- Continue until you come to a set of traffic lights. Go through the first and second set of lights and continue along Dumbarton Road for approximately one quarter of a mile.
- Turn right into Agamemnon Street.
- At the mini roundabout, turn right into the hospital and hotel complex.
