## 1 Background

The Person Centred and Staff Governance (PCSG) Committee was held on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2020, the following key points were noted at the meeting.

Person Centred	<ul> <li>Committee members welcomed the Executive team approval for volunteers to return on site in the ophthalmology and welcome guide roles and that work is ongoing with the Princes Trust and young volunteers along with plans to host events to encourage people to pursue careers in healthcare.</li> <li>Committee members noted that following a gap analysis, the Health and Wellbeing Group have formed 3 short life working groups to progress services for staff for mental, physical as well as social and financial health and wellbeing. The Health and Wellbeing Strategy will be presented to the Committee and Board at the November meetings.</li> <li>The Committee discussed the Health and Wellbeing Strategy and agreed to provide comments with a view to approving virtually.</li> <li>The Committee welcomed changes being considered to Human Factors training with the introduction of simulation training.</li> </ul>
Safe	<ul> <li>The Committee noted that Physical Distancing was discussed at the September Partnership Forum meeting. The Committee discussed the challenges around staff compliance and noted the ongoing work to overcome any issues and reminding staff to continue to work on behaviours to adhere to the guidance.</li> <li>Committee members noted the policy tracker and requested that any policies overdue for review were updated as soon as possible, in particular the schools' placement policy.</li> </ul>
