NHS Golden Jubilee Annual Review At a Glance 2024/2025 **Performance**



Golden Jubilee University National Hospital



- Performed **119,848** inpatient, day case, and diagnostic procedures completed.
- **100%** of lung cancer patients treated within the 31-day target.
- UK's highest transplant rate per million population with 29 heart transplants.
- Interventional Cardiology doubled TAVI capacity, treating 449 patients.
- Increased endoscopy capacity by 4.4% to 8,842 procedures.
- Increased orthopaedic capacity 6,223 orthopaedic surgeries with a 29% increase in joint replacements.
- **11,889** cataract procedures.
- 90% of patients were treated within the 12-week Treatment Time Guarantee.

Centre for Sustainable Delivery



- Our Modernising Patient Pathways team led Active Clinical Referral Triage (ACRT) and Patient Initiated Review (PIR) initiatives released over **230,000** appointments, saving **4 million** patient travel miles and avoiding **£45 million** in costs.
- Our National Elective Coordination Unit (NECU) has validated more than 235,000 patients since its programme began, helping reduce waiting times. NECU's targeted campaigns have provided care for over 7,500 patients.
- Our Cancer team helped NHS Forth Valley launch a Rapid Cancer Diagnostic Service, giving **54** GP practices and **306,000** people access to fast diagnosis.
- Our Diabetes Closed Loop National Onboarding Programme moved to business as usual, with 1,065 people onboarded during the
 year.

NHS Scotland Academy



- The NHS Scotland Academy trained **13** sonographers and **28** resident doctors, increasing ultrasound scans by **27**%.
- Endoscopy training expanded with 569 learners completing programmes, a 315% increase supporting diagnostic capacity.

Golden Jubilee Conference Hotel



- Supported patient care by providing 8,229 patient bedrooms.
- Welcomed 12,638 conference delegates through our doors.

The Board achieved a surplus of £51,000, delivered £10.5 million in savings, and invested £14.7 million in capital projects including the Surgical Centre and new medical equipment.

Carbon emissions reduced through patient medication initiatives, waste segregation, LED lighting, and fleet travel reductions.

Staff headcount rose by 4.5% to 2,613.



Turnover decreased to 7.8%.



Appraisal completion rates reached 68% for Agenda for Change staff and 78% for medical staff.

12% more staff completed iMatter, with Employee Engagement Index rising to 77/100.



64 volunteers provided more than 21,000 hours of support to patients.

Our Research Institute exceeded its income target:

- 95% of projects approved
- 109 journal articles published
