MPPP: Drive transformational change focused on patient access & outcomes

ACRT: 179k+ appointments saved (year to date).
PIR: 70k+ patients on PIR pathways (year to date).

National Clinical Pathways: Formal sign off and approval of Urology Hyperplasia, Critical Care Remote & Rural pathways.

Active Dissemination: 68k+ page views (year to date) across Resources and Tools on Right Decision Service.

NECU: Support Boards with patient validation and allocation of national capacity.

Health Board Patient waiting lists: 84k+ patients validated (year to date).

Dermatology Photo Triage: co-ordinated and triaged 4100+ in total (year to date) achieving 53% advice & discharge rate.

Digital Validation Platform: completed User Acceptance Testing. Issues collated and reported to provider.

Unscheduled Care: Define national best practice for unscheduled care

Flow Navigation: held Flow Navigation SLWG, with focus on data and definitions to support reducing variation.

Front Door Medicine: finalised Same Day Emergency Care guiding principles and prepared for formal publication.

Analytics: Launched Health Board Unscheduled Care weekly Dashboard. Flow Navigation Centre version in development.


Cancer Improvement and Earlier Diagnosis: Support delivery of Scotland's national 10-year cancer strategy

Rapid Cancer Diagnostic Service: Annual report published including comms support. Published patient experience quotes on CfSD website.
